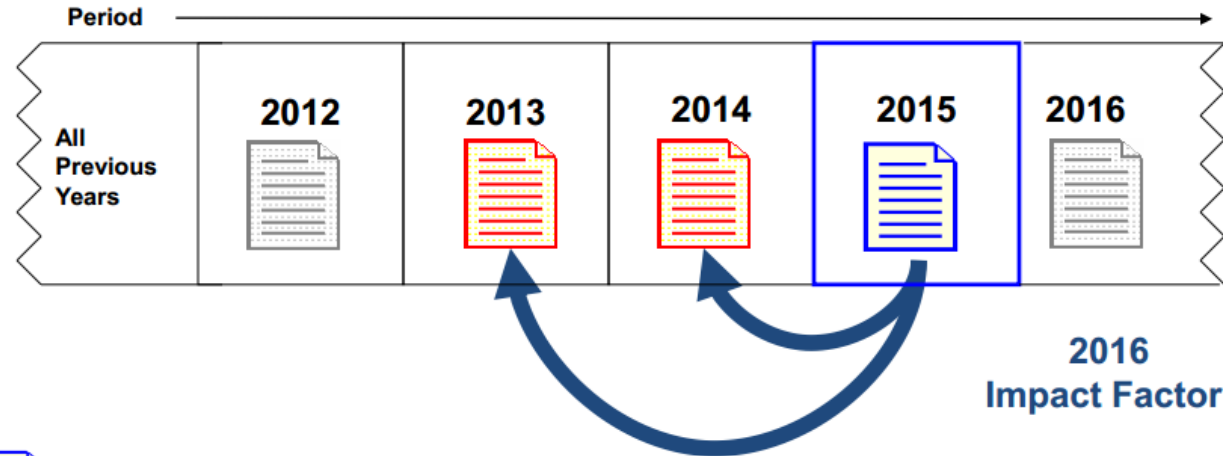

Abstract

We develop a new index of economic policy uncertainty (EPU) based on newspaper coverage frequency. Several types of evidence-including human readings of 12,000 newspaper articles-indicate that our index proxies for movements in policy-related economic uncertainty. Our U.S. index spikes near tight presidential elections, Gulf Wars I and II, the 9/11 attacks, the failure of Lehman Brothers, the 2011 debt ceiling dispute, and other major battles over fiscal policy. Using firm-level data, we find that policy uncertainty is associated with greater stock price volatility and reduced investment and employment in policy-sensitive sectors like defense, health care, finance, and infrastructure construction. At the macro level, innovations in policy uncertainty foreshadow declines in investment, output, and employment in the United States and, in a panel vector autoregressive setting, for 12 major economies. Extending our U.S. index back to 1900, EPU rose dramatically in the 1930s (from late 1931) and has drifted upward since the 1960s.

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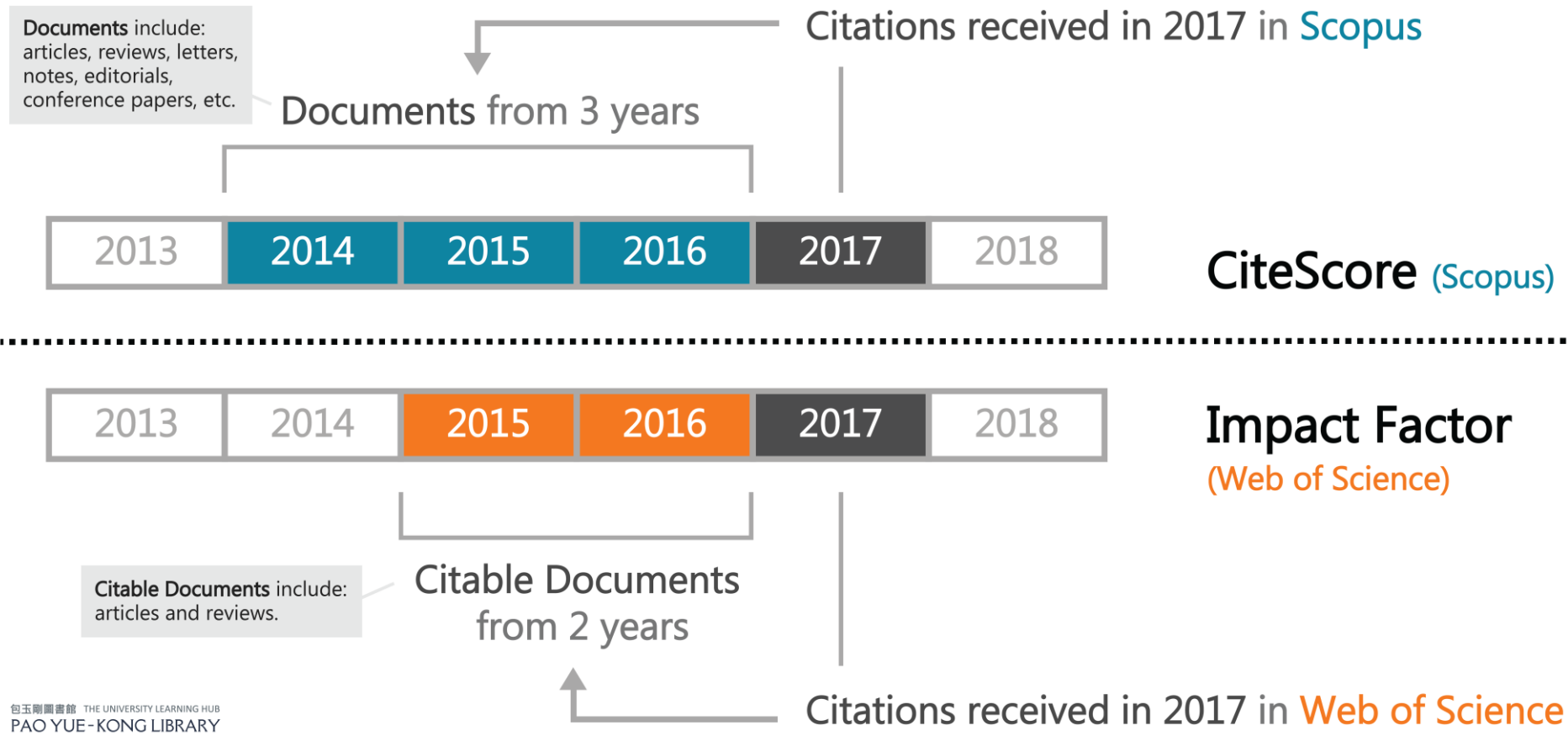
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# Plagiarism

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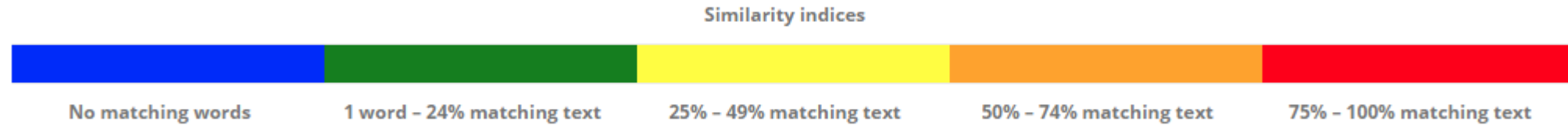

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# Avoid Plagiarism

---

To avoid plagiarism, you must give credit whenever you use:

- ✓ another person's idea, opinion, or theory;
- ✓ any facts, statistics, graphs, drawings—any pieces of information—that are not common knowledge;
- ✓ quotations of another person's actual spoken or written words; or
- ✓ paraphrase of another person's spoken or written words.

## **To show time:**

after, afterward, as, as long as, as soon as, at last, before, during, earlier, finally, formerly, immediately, later, meanwhile, next, since, shortly, subsequently, then, thereafter, until, when, while

## **To show place or direction:**

above, below, beyond, close, elsewhere, farther on, here, nearby, opposite, to the left (north, etc.)

## **To indicate logical relationship:**

accordingly, as a result, because, consequently, for this reason, hence, if, otherwise, since, so, then, therefore, thus

## Useful Transition: Best Practice (2)

---

### **To show addition:**

again, and, also, besides, equally important, first (second, etc.), further, furthermore, in addition, in the first place, moreover, next, too

### **To give examples:**

for example, for instance, in fact, specifically, that is, to illustrate

### **To compare:**

also, in the same manner, likewise, similarly

### **To contrast:**

although, and yet, at the same time, but, despite, even though, however, in contrast, in spite of, nevertheless, on the contrary, on the other hand, still, though, yet

## Paraphrasing: an example

---

The rise of industry, the growth of cities, and the expansion of the population were the three great developments of late nineteenth century American history. As new, larger, steam-powered factories became a feature of the American landscape in the East, they transformed farm hands into industrial laborers, and provided jobs for a rising tide of immigrants. With industry came urbanization the growth of large cities (like Fall River, Massachusetts, where the Borden's lived) which became the centers of production as well as of commerce and trade.

### Here's an **ACCEPTABLE** paraphrase

Fall River, where the Borden family lived, was typical of northeastern industrial cities of the nineteenth century. Steam-powered production had shifted labor from agriculture to manufacturing, and as immigrants arrived in the US, they found work in these new factories. As a result, populations grew, and large urban areas arose. Fall River was one of these manufacturing and commercial centers (Williams, 1980, p.1).
